

Accident Investigation Training



Program Overview:

This program is recommended for JHSC Members, Managers, Supervisors, and OH&S Representatives. It provides information and tools to aid in the investigations of employee accidents in order to prevent them from recurring. The course, approximately eight (8) hours long, with the content adjusted for either Federal or Provincial as per request. Regulations reviewed will include the OHSA, Regulation 834/90(Critical Injury), WSIB and MOL Reporting Requirements – for Federal Employees – Canada Labour Code Part II.

All Successful Participants receive a certificate stating that they have successfully completed the course.
